

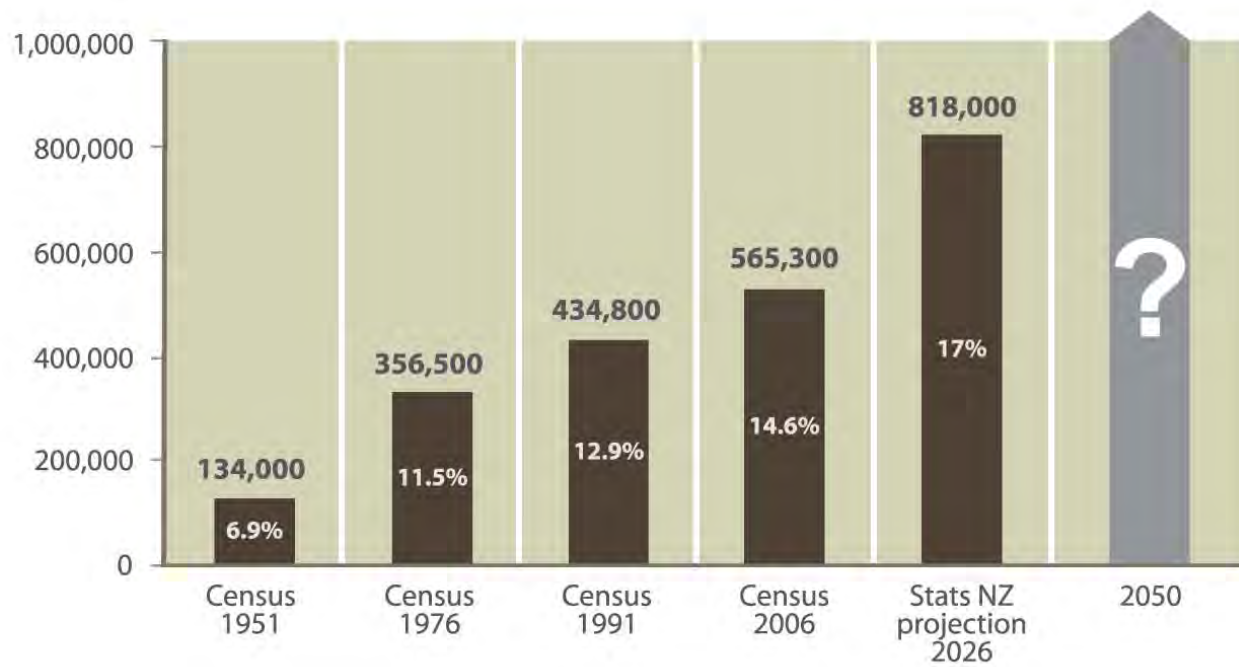

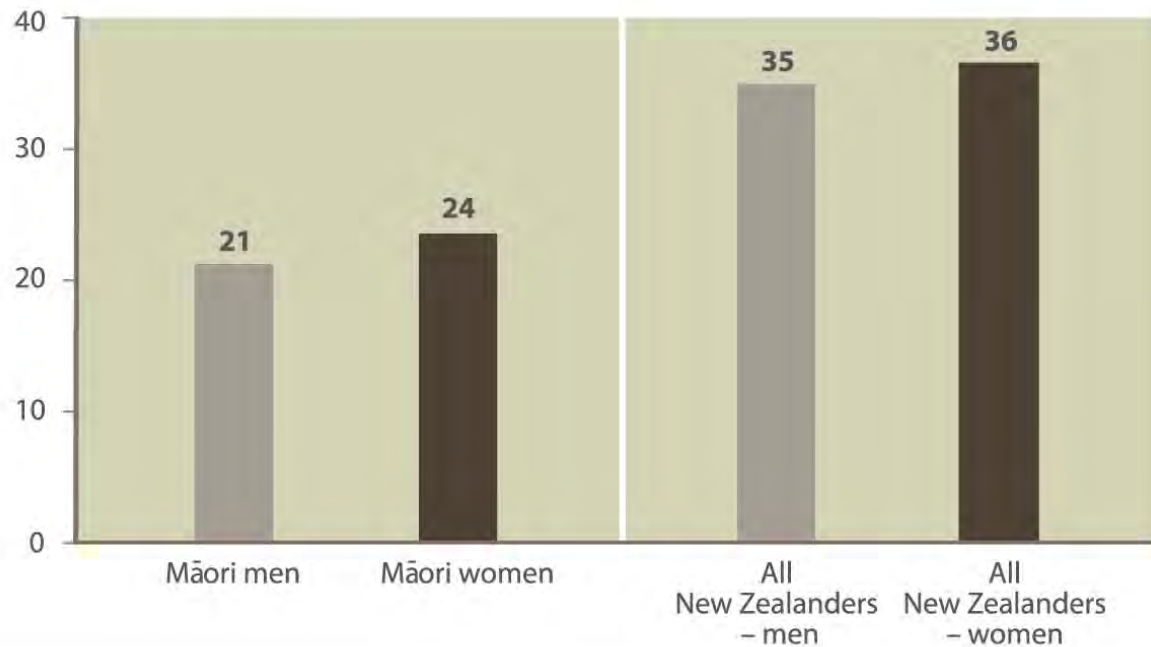

Growth of the Māori Population



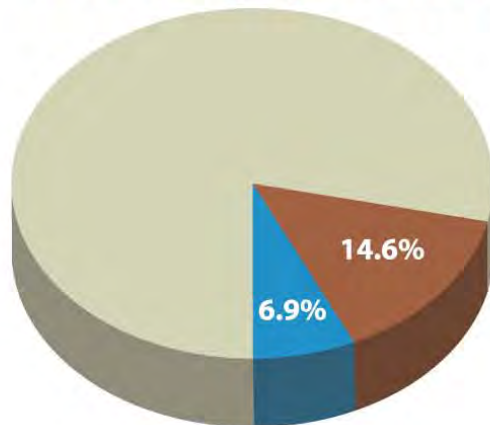
Median age of Māori and all New Zealanders Census 2006

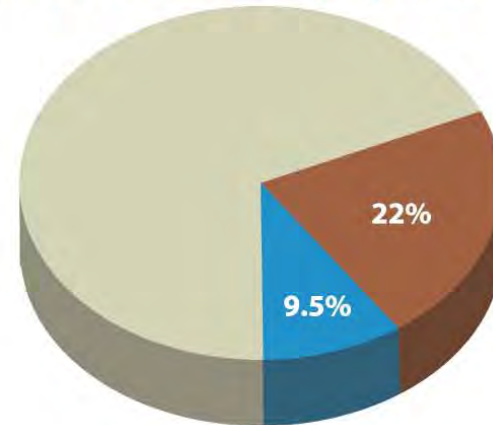
Māori and Pasifika today – a young population

Pasifika population – 6.9%

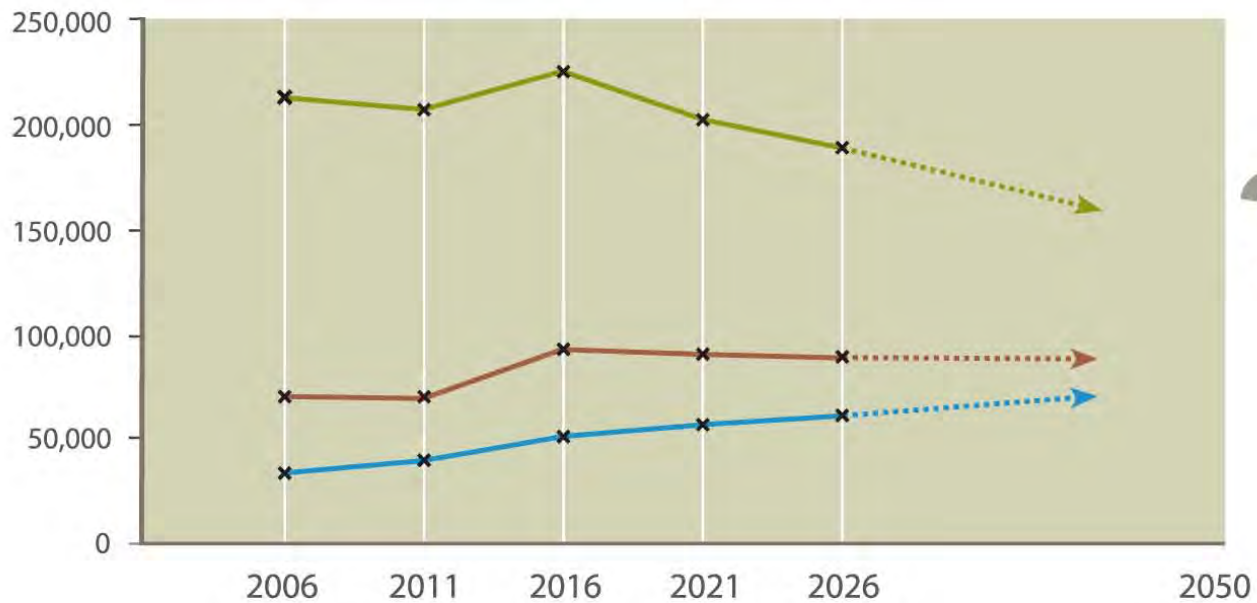
% of student population
