- Clutha/Mata Au Scholarships** (2 undergraduate at \$2,500.00 each; 1 postgraduate at \$7,500.00)

These scholarships, funded by Contact Energy, are based on academic excellence in an area of study that will improve the management of natural resources within the Clutha/Mata Au or improve water management within the Ngāi Tahu takiwā generally. These scholarships may be applied for in addition to the Ka Putea scholarships listed above. Preference will normally be given to students whose studies have a direct link to the Clutha/Mata Au.
