

Whai Rawa Fund and Ngāi Tahu Tourism Competition

General Competition Terms and Conditions including:

Eligibility, Entry, The Prize, Winner Selection and Contact

This competition is organised, promoted and run by Te Rūnanga o Ngāi Tahu's Whai Rawa Fund and Ngāi Tahu Tourism Ltd ("the Promoters").

1. These terms and conditions together with any further rules set out in any relevant associated competition documentation are the Competition Rules ("the Rules") and apply to the competition outlined at www.whairawa.com ("the Competition"), unless otherwise expressly stated. By entering the Competition, entrants agree to be bound by the Rules.
2. A valid entry will comprise of the correctly completed entry form together with the deposit of funds into the members Whai Rawa account of \$12.50 for a child member and \$50.00 for an adult member during the qualifying period, 1 January 2012 to 30 March 2012.
3. Each entry must be made on the official entry form.
4. The cost of each entry is the responsibility of the entrant, and includes gaining permission from the bill payer prior to entering the competition if necessary.
5. By entering the Competition the winner(s) and companions agree to their names and photographs being published by the Promoters for publicity purposes.

Proof of posting or emailing will not be accepted as proof of delivery or receipt of entries.

The Promoters do not accept responsibility for any error, omission, interruption, deletion, defect, delay in operation or transmission, communications line failure, theft, destruction, alteration of, or unauthorised access to entries, or entries lost or delayed whether or not arising during operation or transmission as a result of server functions, virus, bugs or other causes.

6. Any prizes are not transferable or exchangeable and cannot be redeemed for cash.

20. If the prize winner cannot be contacted within 3 days from the prize draw, at the Promoters option that winner will forfeit the prize with no right of compensation and the prize will be redrawn.

To the full extent permitted by law, the Promoters will not be liable to any party in respect of any claim for any loss, damage or injury whatsoever (including, without limitation, any consequential, indirect, special, punitive or incidental damages) or for any physical or mental injury suffered by the winner or friend as a result of or in connection with the Competition or by reason of the utilisation or application of any prize won in the Competition.

If for any reason this Competition is not capable of running as planned including, but not limited to infection by computer virus, tampering, unauthorised intervention, fraud, technical failures or any other causes beyond the control of the Promoters which corrupts or affects the administration, security, fairness, integrity or proper conduct of the Competition, the Promoters reserve the right in its sole discretion to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the Competition.
32. The Promoters reserve the right to disqualify any entrant if it has reasonable grounds to believe the entrant has breached any of these terms and conditions.

33. The Winner will be determined by the Promoters who shall for this purpose be deemed the Judge.
